

**NEW MEXICO STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT PROGRAM**  
**TEST ASSIGNMENT PROCEDURES FOR ENROLLED STUDENTS**  
**SPRING 2017**

This document provides state requirements regarding which statewide assessment(s) students should take during the Spring 2017 administration. **English Language Arts (ELA)**

1. Students in grades 3–8 must take their grade-level PARCC ELA test.
2. Students in grades 9–11 must take their grade-level PARCC ELA tests **unless** they are enrolled in a higher level ELA course. In that case, they may take the PARCC ELA test corresponding to their course. Students in grades 9–11 enrolled in a course lower than their grade level (e.g., an 11<sup>th</sup> grade student enrolled in English/Language Arts II) must take their grade-level PARCC test.
3. Eligible Spanish-speaking EL students may take the Spanish Reading SBA in grades 3-8 and 11. High School students who take the Spanish Reading SBA must also take a Writing EoC exam for graduation requirements.
4. PARCC grade 11 ELA is the only PARCC ELA test that counts for graduation. Students in grade 12 and accelerated high school students not enrolled in English/Language Arts III may take the PARCC grade 11 ELA test in order to meet graduation requirements.

**Mathematics**

1. Students in grades 3-8 must take their grade-level PARCC Math test with the following exception: middle school students (grades 6-8) may take a high school PARCC Math test if enrolled in a PARCC-aligned high school Math course for high school credit.
2. Students in grades 9–11 must take the PARCC Math test that aligns to the course in which they are enrolled, as shown on the following page, with the following exception: students concurrently enrolled in two PARCC-aligned Math courses must take one PARCC test but may take both.
3. Eligible Spanish-speaking EL students may take the PARCC Math test in Spanish.
4. Students in grade 12 and accelerated high school students not enrolled in a PARCC-aligned Math course may take a PARCC Math test in order to meet graduation requirements.

**Science**

1. Students in grades 4, 7, and 11 must take their grade-level SBA science test.
2. High school students take the grade 11 SBA science test when they have enough credits to be 11<sup>th</sup> graders as defined by the district/charter school, regardless of their number of years in high school.
3. Eligible Spanish-speaking EL students may take SBA science assessments in Spanish.
4. Students in grade 12 may take the grade 11 SBA science test in order to meet graduation requirements.

## Social Studies

1. High school students must take one state-developed social studies EoC exam to meet graduation requirements.

## Other Testing Requirements

1. Students in **rolling-enrollment courses** should take the PARCC test aligned to their current courses as long as they have completed **50% of the course** before they begin testing.
